

**Zoe Louise DeMeyers** was born in 2003 with Aicardi-Goutières Syndrome (AGS). AGS has caused the calcification of Zoe's brain. As the calcification spreads, it takes away normal abilities that the brain would control.

At this time, Zoe is non-ambulatory, non-communicative and has permanent blindness. The syndrome has taken from Zoe normal functions such as eating, muscle control and speech resulting in 24 hour care by nurses and parents. AGS is a very rare, degenerative disorder with a finite lifespan and Zoe receives new types of treatment in order to research her conditions.
