Job Purpose:

To provide oversight and support to the firm's investment operations. Responsibilities include compliance, execution, and review for portfolio management and compliance firm liaison.

Essential Functions:

Compliance Oversight

- Facilitating the relationship with our compliance firm and providing requested data
 - Managing the annual audit process for our compliance firm and broker dealer
 - o Updating and broadcasting of client related forms
- Firm sign off on client documents
- Audit oversight of affiliate offices
 - o Perform Branch audits
- Quarterly compliance monitoring of portfolio allocation against current base model
 Leading meetings with senior officers to review outstanding accounts
- Daily review of trade accuracy including analysis of outside positions, employee trading, and other anomalies
- Quarterly review of SEC Rule 606 (best execution) Reports

Trade and Billing Management

- Managing trade execution and reconciliation for incoming and outgoing funds daily
 - Leading weekly meetings on outstanding investments, debits, and maturing issues
 - o Processing quarterly and annual portfolio rebalances
 - Processing bond trades including allocation and file retention
- Assist in the completion of the billing process from initial coding to preparation and reporting, to final reconciliation
- Executing portfolio implementation and modification across multiple platforms
- Facilitating the trade correction and reporting process
- Assist in research of companies to use in model allocations
- Research and provide current Fixed Income inventory Portfolio Managers
